# ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED THEOLOGY

The Associate of Applied Theology is a practical degree that is designed for students who are centred in their desire to prepare for Christian ministry vocations.

The degree program is structured to provide a strong biblical/theological/practical ministry foundation for leadership and includes opportunities for students to structure their own program to meet perceived needs in ministry.

The Associate of Applied Theology degree program consists of 60 credit hours with the following components:

**Foundational Studies:** 15 credit hours

**Core Requirements:** 21 credit hours (Courses that are in Applied Theology)

**Electives:** 24 credit hours

# ASSOCIATE OF LEADERSHIP & ORGANIZATION

The Associate of Leadership and Organization degree offers the student the opportunity to develop and exercise their leadership and organization skills within churches, para-church ministries, and Christian nonprofit organizations. This degree will teach students how to develop a team, discover leadership strengths and weaknesses, achieve resolution and communicate effectively.

The Associate of Leadership and Organization degree program consists of 60 credit hours with the following components:

**Foundational Studies:** 15 credit hours

**Core Requirements:** 21 credit hours (Courses that are in Leadership and Organization)

**Electives:** 24 credit hours

# BACHELOR OF APPLIED THEOLOGY

The Bachelor of Applied Theology is a practical degree that is designed for students who are centred in their desire to prepare for Christian ministry vocations. The degree program is structured to provide a strong biblical/theological/practical ministry foundation for leadership and includes opportunities for students to structure their own program to meet perceived needs in ministry.

The Bachelor of Applied Theology degree program consists of 120 credit hours with the following components.

<b>Foundational Studies:</b>	30 credit hours
<b>Core Requirements:</b>	45 credit hours (Courses that are in Applied Theology)
<b>Electives:</b>	45 credit hours

# BACHELOR OF THEOLOGICAL STUDIES

The Bachelor of Theological Studies is a degree that provides students with an understanding of the history, context and message of the Bible. In addition, this degree teaches the historical and theological developments within a framework of Christianity.

The Bachelor of Theological Studies degree program consists of 120 credit hours with the following components.

<b>Foundational Studies:</b>	30 credit hours
<b>Core Requirements:</b>	45 credit hours (Courses that are in Theological Studies)
<b>Electives:</b>	45 credit hours

# BACHELOR OF CHRISTIAN COUNSELLING

The Bachelor of Christian Counselling degree is designed to broaden the understanding of the multi-faceted aspects of Christian counselling. This program will equip ministry practitioners with the skills to counsel from a Biblical and Christian perspective and will enhance their effectiveness of ministering to people. This program is not designed to prepare a student for state exams or to practice in secular counselling environments.

The Bachelor of Christian Counselling degree program consists of 120 credit hours with the following components:

- Foundational Studies:** 30 credit hours
- Core Requirements:** 45 credit hours  
(Courses that are in Christian Counselling)
- Electives:** 45 credit hours

# MASTER OF APPLIED THEOLOGY (MAT)

The Master of Applied Theology (MAT) is a 36 credit hour program designed to provide training and understanding of the practical sides of ministry. Depending on the courses chosen, a graduate with an Applied Theology degree will have skills in: Bible interpretation, Sermon and Bible Study construction, pastoral and biblical counselling, personal evangelism and principles of organization and administration.

The Master of Applied Theology (MAT) program consists of the following components:

- Prerequisite hours if applicable:** 30 credit hours of Bible/Theology
- Core Requirements:** 24 credit hours  
(Courses that are in Applied Theology)
- Electives:** 6 hours (Any courses that we offer in any department)
- Thesis/Project\*:** 6 hours

# MASTER OF CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT (MLM)

The Masters in Christian Leadership and Management (MLM) degree offers the student the opportunity to develop and exercise their leadership and management skills within churches, para-church ministries and Christian non-profit organizations. Students will be guided in creating a custom degree program that will match their needs and interests.

A Masters of Christian Leadership and Management (MLM) program consists of the following components:

<b>Prerequisite hours if applicable:</b>	30 credit hours of Bible/Theology
<b>Core Requirements:</b>	24 credit hours (Courses in Leadership and Management)
<b>Electives:</b>	6 hours (Any courses that we offer in any department)
<b>Thesis/Project*</b>	6 hours

# THE MASTER OF THEOLOGY

The Master of Theology (MTh) degree program is designed for those students who anticipate having a strong exegetical foundation for preaching and teaching. This degree program is a 60 hour program and includes at least two courses in Biblical languages. The Master of Theology degree provides a solid foundation for pursuing the Doctor of Theology (ThD) degree or the Doctor of Religious Philosophy (PhRd) program through LOGOS.

The Master of Theology (ThM) degree program consists of the following components:

<b>Prerequisite hours if applicable:</b>	30 credit hours of Bible/Theology
<b>Old and New Testament Studies:</b>	18 hours
<b>Theological Studies:</b>	12 hours
<b>Systematics:</b>	15 hours
<b>Hermeneutics:</b>	3 hours
<b>Biblical Languages:</b>	6 hours
<b>Thesis/Project</b>	6 hours

# DOCTOR OF MINISTRY

The Doctor of Ministry degree program is designed to assist those in ministry in acquiring a specialty in a specific discipline. The courses in this program are practical and theological in nature rather than theoretical. The concentration of the degree will allow the graduate to have more options in being placed in ministry. Having acquired the normative skills for ministry, recipients of a Doctor of Ministry with concentration can also present themselves as specialists in a field as well as general practitioners.

There are seven (7) Doctor of Ministry program concentrations to choose from, each with a different concentration. The concentration choices are listed below:

- **Applied Theology**
- **Biblical Studies**
- **Chaplaincy**
- **Christian Counselling**
- **Christian Education**
- **Leadership and Management**
- **Theological Studies**

Each of these Doctor of Ministry degrees are custom-designed depending on the concentration.

In addition to the prerequisite of 30 hours of bible and theology, the Doctor of Ministry program consists of the following components:

2. Original and sealed Office Transcripts from all previous learning institutions sent directly to LOGOS.
3. Students are to be actively involved in a local church.
4. Admission to LOGOS is subject to approval by Admission Committee, whose decision is final.

### ITEMS REQUIRED FOR COMPLETING THE APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. A completed Application
2. \$30 nonrefundable made payable to LOWCF Church ( see attached)
3. Transcripts: Official High School
4. A current photograph of applicant (alone and preferably 2x2)

LOGOS is an Equal Opportunity Institution of higher learning. Information provided is confidential in accordance with the Family Education Rights & Privacy Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-380) Written authorization by student is required to release information.

Upon receipt of the above items, LOGOS will ascertain proficiency to determine placement in the highest program, and provide the students with an evaluation letter outlining their course of study for the major they have chosen. Because we are a Christian university, all Applicants must have in their educational portfolio a minimum of 30 credit hours of Bible/Theology on the undergraduate or graduate level in addition to the requirements for their program. Students who do not have the prerequisite hours may be eligible for Advanced Standing through Life and Ministry Experience credit and by taking our Basic Bible Knowledge Exam for up to a maximum of 30 semester hours of credit. There are forms available on the website ([www.logos.edu](http://www.logos.edu)) for this purpose. When applying for admission, those students who desire Advance Standing should request this option in the cover letter. All information submitted for Life and Ministry Experience credit must be verifiable. Any shortage of hours for the prerequisite will be added to the length of the graduate program.
